- Experience with automation/configuration management using tools such as Chocolatey
- Experience with Jenkins
- Ability to use a wide variety of open source technologies
- A working understanding of code and script (PowerShell, C#, etc.)
- Knowledgeable of best practices and IT operations in an always-up, always-available service
- Knowledge of CI/CD with Azure Devops
- Overseeing the deployment process of our products (AWS and on-site)
- Working to find new automation opportunities within the company
- Working on cloud implementations and improving existing implementations
- Writing code/script as necessary and using open source tools to complete tasks
- Be a liaison between development teams, support, and IT on infrastructure and development projects
